



**INVERELL 100m SMALL BORE & FIELD PISTOL
METALLIC SILHOUETTE
28TH TO 30TH MAY 2021
VENUE: Inverell RSM Pistol Club – Delungra Range**

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: All competitors MUST be members of NSWAPA or some other State body affiliated with Pistol Australia.

The shoot will be conducted over 3 days. Persons entering 4 or more matches should be available for all 3 days **All competitors and visitors will comply with the relevant COVID 19 health requirements. If you are displaying any cold/flu like symptoms, have been in contact with Covid 19 or have been in a COVID 19 HOTSPOT please do not attend the range, Inverell RSM Pistol Club reserves the right to ask anyone with symptoms to leave the range,**

All matches will be conducted under IMSSU Rules as adopted by Pistol Australia. Full jacket projectiles are permitted in Revolver only.

Shooters or their spotters will be required to reset and paint targets. Ensure that your target setter is capable of resetting targets. Use care when lifting targets. It is recommended that gloves be worn when setting targets.

Suitable footwear and clothing must be worn on the range. Children must be under direct supervision at all times.

Qualified or suitably experienced persons will be squadded for Range duties. Commencement times will be advised with squadding. Shooters should be ready 10 minutes before their scheduled relay.

The range will be available for practice on Wednesday 26th May 2021 from noon to 4 pm and Thursday 27th May 2021 8:30am to 4 pm. Gun check and registration will open on Thursday afternoon and one hour before shooting commences on the days of the competition. Grading cards will be collected at registration. Pistol licenses or permits will be checked at registration and each day.

TIED SCORES: Will be decided as follows:

First place in each category by shoot off. All other ties will be decided by reverse animal count. If still equal then by shoot off. Match aggregate ties will be decided by count-back of total number of rams etc., if still equal then a shoot off consisting of 5 shots per category will be used to decide.

Shoot off targets will be:

- a - SB Production and Revolver – SB turkey, pig, chicken, pig, turkey at 100m.
- b - SB Standing and Field Pistol – turkeys at 75m.
- c - SB Unlimited – Unlimited turkey, pig, chicken, pig, turkey at 100m.

Shoot offs will be exhaustive

CATERING: Canteen facilities will be available over the three days of competition.

ACCOMMODATION: Contact the Tourist Information Centre Phone (02) 6728 8161. On site camping with hot showers available at \$12 per person for the competition. Need to provide own power. Water is from a rainwater tank, so you may wish to bring your own drinking water.
