VENUE: NARRABRI PISTOL CLUB, 63 PISTOL CLUB ROAD, NARRABRI 2390.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- 1 All resident Australian competitors must be a current financial member of Target Pistol Australia (TPA).
- 2 Target Pistol Australia (TPA), NSWAPA and Narrabri Pistol Club Codes of Conduct will apply.
- 3 All competitors, visitors and volunteers will comply with any health requirements in force at the time.
- 4 **Shooting mats will not be supplied. Please bring your own mat.**
- 5 The Competition will be held over three days. Competitors shooting more than 4 matches should be available for the three days.
- 6 Handgun matches will be conducted in accordance with IMSSU Rules as adopted by Target Pistol Australia. Full jacketed projectiles are permitted in Revolvers only.
- 7 Shooters or their spotters will be required to reset and paint targets. Ensure targets are lifted in the correct manner and are within your physical capabilities. It is recommended that gloves be worn.
- 8 Only suitable clothing and footwear that comply with TPA; NSWAPA & Narrabri PC guidelines permitted. Offensive clothing, singlets, crop tops, short shorts, camo etc. are not permitted.
- 9 Children must be under the direct supervision of a responsible adult at all times.
- 10 Shooting will commence at approximately 8:30 am. Shooters should be ready 10 minutes before their relay.
- 11 The range will be available for practice on Thursday prior to the competition until 4.00pm.
- 12 Registration & Gun Check Thursday afternoon and at 7.30 am prior to the commencement of shooting each day. Grading cards will be collected and Membership cards & Licences/Permits checked at Registration.
- 13 Suitably qualified/experienced persons will be squadded for Range duties.
- 14 TIED SCORES: Will be decided as follows:
 - (i) First place in each category by shoot off.
 - (ii) Grade ties will be decided by reverse animal count, if still equal then by shoot off.
 - (iii) Tied match aggregates will be decided by count back, commencing with rams. If still equal, a shoot off consisting of 5 shots per category will decide. Shoot offs will be exhaustive.
 - (iv) Shoot off targets will be:
 - Standing – Full size turkeys at 150m
 - Revolver, Production and Unlimited Full Scale – Half scale turkey, pig, chicken, pig, turkey at 200m
 - Unlimited- Half scale pig, chicken, pig, chicken, pig at 200m
- 15 Two off gun 100m Rifle Lever Action Metallic Silhouette matches will be conducted as side matches.
(1) Pistol Cartridge Centre Fire Cowboy Lever Action; (2) Smallbore Cowboy Rifle.
- 16 You acknowledge that you may be photographed/videoed and results, photographs/video may be published on the Narrabri PC, NSWAPA, TPA and commercial websites or social and print media.
- 17 The John Ford Steel Challenge handicap match will be held in conjunction at no charge.

- 19 Camping facilities are available at the range at your own risk at \$15 per person for the competition.

CATERING FACILITIES including **breakfast** will be available on all three days.
